

Dear Residents,

This eBlast serves as a correction to last week's communication regarding street oak trees.

On April 1, 2026, we received an email from Barrett Cruze, the City Forester for Palm Beach Gardens. In that email, he stated that a tree removal permit would be required from the City prior to the removal of any trees.

Following that communication, we consulted with our attorney regarding the HOA's authority over these trees. A summary of that discussion was included in the previous eBlast.

On the afternoon of Friday, April 17, 2026, we received a phone call from Mr. Cruze. During that conversation, he clarified that the information in his April 1 email was incorrect and that a City permit is not required for tree removal. He apologized for any misunderstanding or inconvenience this may have caused.

The information provided in the original eBlast, as it pertains to the HOA's authority, remains unchanged. For further details, please refer to the eBlast sent on April 17, 2026.
